



Code of Conduct

Identification

All participating students must always carry their valid school-issued ID card; in addition to the conference ID tag that will be issued upon registration. Students who do not have their school-issued ID cards will be refused entry into the conference. Please note that the conference staff reserves the right to check the conference badges or student ID of any participant at any time, for any reason whatsoever.

Smoking

The smoking of cigarettes, vapes, or substitutes is strictly prohibited across all Westminster campuses and affiliate venues that may be employed by the conference. Students carrying any such item will be refused entry.

Curfew

A curfew will be strictly enforced by the Westminster management. A curfew will come into effect half an hour after the activities for the day have ended. After curfew, Delegates and all other participants must leave the campus or move to a designated area if they are waiting to be picked up.

Faculty Advisor or Chaperone

Any accompanying faculty advisors will be granted entry into the conference upon showing a valid employee card. Faculty advisors are to assist in achieving delegate compliance with conference rules and policies throughout the conference and are ultimately responsible for the conduct of their delegates.

Valuables

If delegates must bring valuables, they are encouraged to exercise caution and keep their valuables safe. The host institution will not take any liability for lost or stolen valuables.

Behavior

WMUN will not tolerate any instances of harassment or discrimination, including but not limited to those based on race, gender, sex, national origin, religion, age, or disability status. Further, the conference will not tolerate any instances of inappropriate behavior or unwelcome advances. If any delegate, staff member, or advisor believes they have encountered harassment or discrimination, they are encouraged to bring it to the attention of the administrative staff.

Expulsion

The Secretariat and administration reserve the right to expel any delegate, delegation, school, or group thereof from the conference at any time for violating or failing to comply with conference regulations, or for any other reason.
